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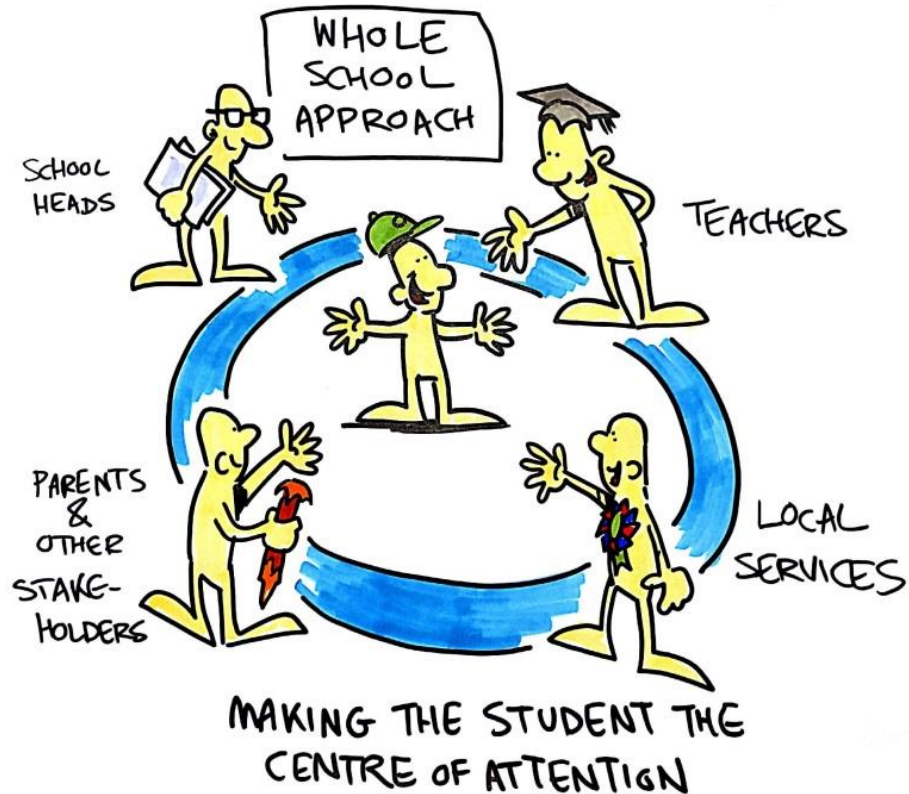

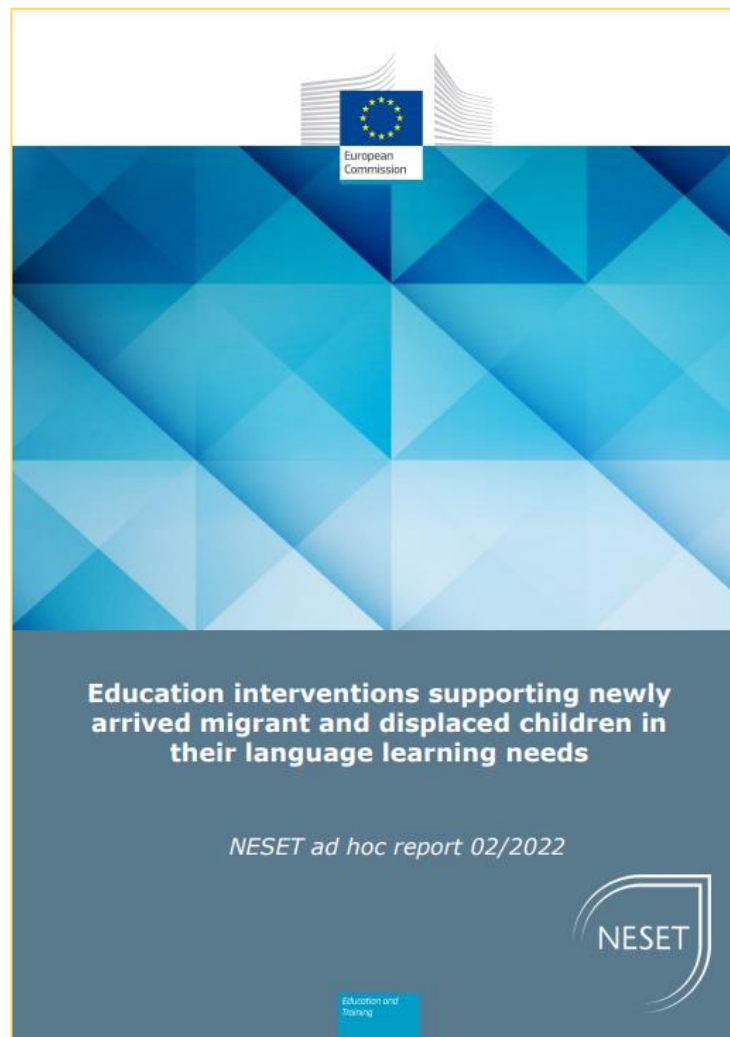

This will also affect their learning experience. It is therefore important for schools, in particular those currently welcoming a large number of refugees, to become 'refugee-competent'.
